Identify Brazil on a world map/globe, find the capital city Brasilia. Watch clips from the 2016 Olympics in Brazil

Look at pictures and maps of Brazil and Brasilia and compare the physical and human features to the UK and London. Find differences and similarities between life in Brazil and life in the UK.

Compare the continents of Europe and South America

Look at flags of different countries around the world. What colours and shapes are used in different flags? Make flags of countries they have visited or would like to visit

Life Skills

What different things do people celebrate in their life?

What celebrations are in each season?

Make a list of celebrations and festivals.

Describe what happens at these special times. Find images of different celebrations; include personal things such as birthdays, weddings and christenings as well as religious events. Make a celebration card for a family member

Learn some phrases and greetings in Portuguese and listen to the Brazilian and British National Anthems showing clips from sporting events.

Computing

Students create a holiday fact file for Brazil and another country of their choice. Comparing the weather, size, languages, foods and celebrations in the countries.

Watch the film Rio / videos from the Brazilian Tourism Board.

Find out about famous Brazilian sports stars (Pele, Neymar or Ayrton Senna) create a PowerPoint about one of the stars.

Design and make a headdress for a Samba parade / carnival

Explore the colours and textures used during carnivals in Brazil

Listen to Samba music and investigate the types of instruments used to play this music.

Make percussion instruments, what kinds of sounds can be made. Describe which sounds they like or do not like.
